Dental Clinic Opened in July 2009

Dental Clinic is a welcomed addition.

Compassionate Care is pleased to announce that our free dental clinic was opened July 2009. Those individuals suffering from dental pain and infection now have a place to turn for help.

The state of the art clinic was made possible through the generosity of the Midmark Corporation with their donation of three dental operatories and a sterilization lab.

A cooperative effort of many individuals, dental supply distributors and the dental community was involved in completing the project. The clinic is staffed by an oral surgeon, local dentists, dental hygienists and their assistants, all of whom donate their time.

The clinic is open Wednesday and Thursday evenings on an appointment basis. Patient qualifications are those used by Compassionate Care Medical Clinic.

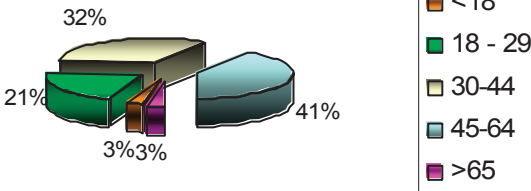

Patient Data 2009

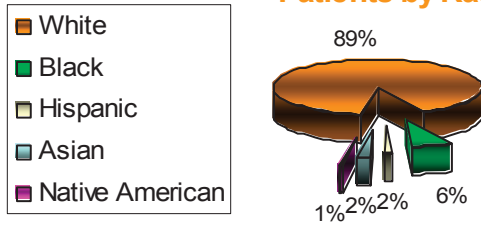
Patients by Gender



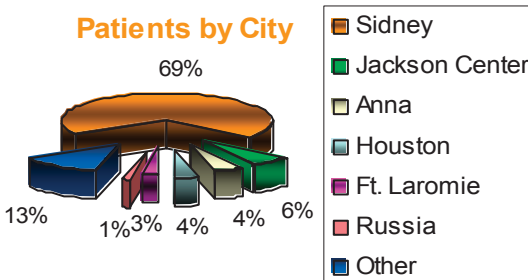
Patients by Age

CCSC Patients

Eligibility requirements for treatment at Compassionate Care include the following: patients must be a Shelby County resident, be uninsured or underinsured, and living at 200% of poverty level. Patients of Compassionate Care are NOT eligible for Medicare or Medicaid.

CCSC Volunteers

With the volunteer physicians, nurse practitioners, nurses, pharmacists, medical assistants and office workers, Compassionate Care is able to provide all of the needed medical care to our community. For 2009 over 6500 hours were donated by more than 90 generous individuals within our community. In addition to healthcare professionals, time was donated by painters, contractors and others who were willing to do anything that was needed at Compassionate Care.

In addition to utilizing community volunteers, Compassionate Care has also served as a clinical training site for Edison State Community College, Wright State University, Ohio State University, Kettering College of Medical Arts, Sinclair Community College and Northwestern University. Students have been given the opportunity to experience community health and in turn, have helped provide healthcare to those in our community.

Medical Visits

Between August 1, 2008 and July 31, 2009, Compassionate Care provided 3119 office visits to 879 unduplicated residents of Shelby County. Without CCSC, many of these patients would have gone without any care at all. The services provided included the diagnosis and treatment of acute illness, as well as management of chronic disease. Preventative screenings have been donated by Component Clinical at a value of over \$166,700.

Prescription Assistance

Our on-site pharmacy allows CCSC to provide medications that patients need as a result of acute illness. Generic medications are purchased in bulk, which keeps the cost as low as possible. 1772 prescriptions were filled from our pharmacy with an estimated value of over \$95,000. Additionally, applications for free brand name medication are completed and sent to the pharmaceutical companies who provide the medications free for those qualify. Volunteer physicians and nurse practitioners are also very committed to prescribing from the Wal-Mart or Kroger \$4 list whenever possible.
